Library card

It is free to get a library card!

With our library card you can borrow books, audio books, movies, e-books, magazines, video-games, and you can use the library's computers. If you have a library card and a pin code, you can also reserve books and download e-books on the library website.

To be able to get a library card you need a valid form of identification. The library card is a personal document and you are responsible to ensure that the items that you borrow do not get damaged or go missing. Contact the library if your library card is missing. The first library card is free of charge. If you need to replace your library card there is a charge of 20 kronor for adults and 10 kronor for children.

As a parent or guardian you are responsible for loans taken out by your child. That is why we need signed approval from you before we can give your child a library card. This concerns children 18 years of age.

Loan periods

Standard loan period – 4 weeks.

Short loan – 14 days.

Movies – 7 days.

Video-games and magazines – 14 days.

You have to be 18 years of age to be able to borrow movies and video-games.

You can use the library card at all libraries in Eskilstuna, the mobile library and Torshälla library.

Renewing loans

You can renew books on the library's website, at the library or by calling the library. You can renew a book three times as long as no one else has reserved it. You need a pin code to renew loans. The reception can help you with getting a pin code.

Reserve books

You can reserve books through the library's website or at the library. You will then be placed in queue and get a message when the item is available for pick-up.

Buying suggestions

You can suggest books for the library to buy. You can either leave a suggestion on the library's website or talk to one of our staff members at the library. You will get a message when the book is available to loan. We will let you know if the book is not purchased.

The staff is happy to help if you have any questions!

Interlibrary loans

If you are unable to find the book you are looking for, it is possible to request the item from another library. You pay a fee when the interlibrary loan is requested.

Reminders and overdue charges

Please keep in mind that someone else may be waiting to loan the items that you have at home. Remember to check the return date of your loan. The last return date is printed on the receipt that you get when you borrow an item.

One week after the return date you will get a reminder to return your loan. An invoice will be sent out after an additional two weeks if you do not return the items that you have on loan.

If you would like to get an overdue notice via email or SMS when it is time to return your items, please notify the reception.

Overdue books

If you have been sent an invoice for overdue books or other materials, you cannot borrow new items or use the computers at the library until you have returned the items or paid the invoice.

You may lose the right to borrow

If you have a debt of 100 kronor or more, you will not be permitted to borrow or use the library computers.

The library is not responsible for damage to your equipment that may be caused by borrowed items, such as audiobooks or movies.
